WA Day of Prayer with the Holy Land: Our speaker



∎this Sunday is Lana Kalis, one of the six million descendants of the Palestinian people who were exiled in the Nakba 1948. Her ancestry dates back to pre-Pentecostal Christianity in Palestine. Lana's father Nadim Saman Kalis, a Nakba survivor, arrived in Walyalup (Fremantle) in the 1960s as a working settler-migrant. Born and raised in Western Australia, Lana is an active member of the Palestinian Christians in Australia, Palestinian Community of WA, Perth Mums for Palestine. She

seeks to raise awareness about the antisemitism by the non-Palestinian Church, and its effect on indigenous Palestinians.
