On Thursday Rev Claire Pickering and the Rev Ana Lea'aetua from the Pastoral Relations Committee met with members of the JCC and the Council members of the two



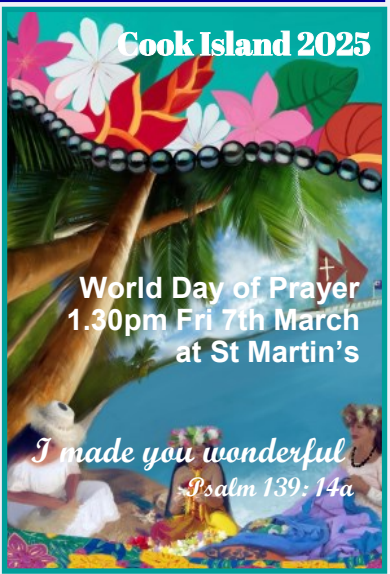
congregations. Clair and Ana outlined the process for the Vitality of Call Consultation. An email with more information from Robert (Chair JCC) is attached.

SHELTER FROM THE SUN AND RAIN!

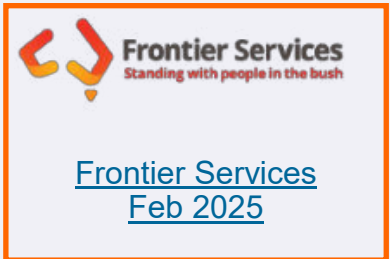
A beautiful bus stop has been erected at the front of our Church. It won't be long before passengers say "drop me off at St Martin's driver"
