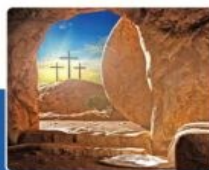

## The Forever Love

God's steadfast love endures forever, we read in Psalm 118. Each week, Alcoholics Anonymous gather at the KUC to grapple with their lives that seem to be out of control and seek to make 12 Steps. The first three are: (1) We admitted we were powerless over alcohol—that our lives had become unmanageable; (2) Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity; and, (3) Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him. One's problems may not be over alcohol. It could be a sense that one can't get over health issues, relationship breakdown, or the uncertainty in the world today. This week, why not reflect on the times you realized that God has your back. This is the Spirit reaching out to awaken our faith not in earthly rulers, but one founded on Jesus, God's love made flesh in history.
