"Love one another as I have loved you." (Jn 31:34-35)

Jesus' new commandment is familiar and challenging. We are instructed not just to love one another, we are given a specific way of loving - "as I have loved you". It is different from the way the world loves, where I scratch your back if you scratch mine. Jesus illustrates this by washing the feet of *all* his disciples, giving this command *after* Judas had left to betray him. He is saying: Live as servants to each other. Live this way regardless. Live this way because this is how others will see him as present when they see your community. This code of conduct "so that others know that you are my disciples" echoes at Eastertide with hints of glory (v31). Today let us look at how we might love because we are loved totally. Practice Resurrection today: love one another as Jesus loves us. --Sophia
