Trek 4 Timor update A total of \$4,670 was raised for the Mobile Medical Clinic driver's salary and associated costs of delivering health services to remote communities in the Baucau district of East Timor.

During the last reporting year (23/24) the mobile clinic visited 14 different remote villages on a regular basis, made 83 visits and had 5,483 consultations.
