

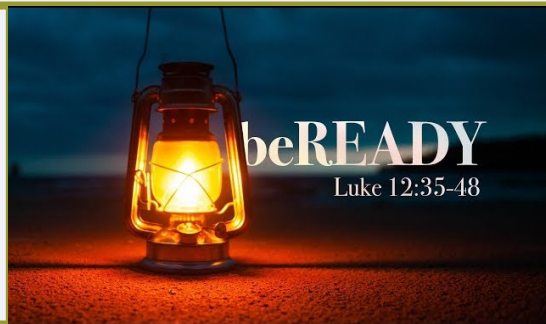

Reflection on Sunday's readings

One of the readings this week introduces us to the Old Testament prophet Isaiah of Jerusalem. He is well connected at Court, is not intimidated but speaks the message that he believes God has given him. Like most prophets he seeks the assurance that he is answering God's calling. This comes to him one day when he is in the temple (see Isaiah 6). His great challenge to the people of Israel, whether they are rich or poor, comes in v18. Here is the Message in a nutshell and with it the assurance that we need.

When we turn to St. Luke's Gospel chapter 12:32-40, Jesus not only states what he expects of his followers but gives them encouragement as he sends them forth. There is a theme in both these readings, that humanity has a need. That is, know the love of God in Christ and for the Church to make it known. Further more, to be aware of the power of the Holy Spirit to do Christ's Work....
