A reflection on Luke 17: 5-10 What is faith? The question is raised by the interaction between Jesus and the Disciples, in this short excerpt from Luke's Gospel (17: 5-10). The disciples ask Jesus to increase their faith; Jesus, instead of responding with action, speaks back to them with a characteristic parabolic saying, about "faith the size of a mustard seed" The mustard seed was allegedly (but not actually) the smallest of all seeds. The point still remains just a little faith has such power contained within it.
