A MAN WITH A MESSAGE We read in St. Matthew's Gospel of an enquiry about the Ministry of Jesus. Another preacher, John the Baptist, heard about Jesus. He wondered if this was the ONE about whom the Prophet Isaiah had foretold years before. John sent his disciples to find Jesus and hear what he was saying and then come back and report to him. They were satisfied that Jesus was indeed fulfilling the Prophetic witness. The Jews of the First century AD assumed that salvation was inherited from their ancestors. However the Gospel message tells us that it is a personal acceptance by faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ. Jesus told John's disciples to see for themselves. There is the living proof. As we celebrate this Christmas season, we know that Jesus came to proclaim the Good News that a Saviour has come with the gift of New Life to all who will receive Him. He is the Saviour.
