



Reflection: John 1: 29 - 42

John sees Jesus and declares, "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" It's a bold proclamation, but what follows is quieter, more personal. Two of John's disciples begin to follow Jesus – not because of a sermon, but because of a simple invitation: "Come and see". Jesus doesn't hand them a doctrinal statement. He doesn't demand credentials. He asks a question: "What are you looking for?"

Listen for Jesus' question: What are you looking for? And be open to his invitation: Come and see. Faith doesn't always start with clarity – often starts with curiosity.
